

Facilities Available

Our maximum capacity is 172 persons cars include one long distance coach which can comfortably accommodate up to 48 persons in reclining seating, equipped with a lavatory, available after leaving town and, in season, comfortable Air Conditioning. Additionally there is an 88-seat commuter car with openable windows and ceiling fans. Comfortable seating for 62+. A second commuter car is equipped with tables and converted for concession operations will seat up to 36 persons, comfortable capacity is 24+. It also has openable windows and ceiling fans. All of the cars can be heated in cooler weather.

Available snacks include pop, water, candy, etc. T-shirts, key rings, whistles, and mugs are some of the souvenirs.

Due to liability concerns there are no hot beverages available.

Box lunches during the ride are available with a varied selection of sandwiches by advance arrangement.

Boarding is from a ground level platform using the traditional step stool plus three steps. Passengers will experience little difficulty in boarding using the handrails.

Movement is possible between cars while the train is moving.

The AC&J is not wheel chair accessible.

Sights along the Way

Enjoy a one hour twelve mile round trip old fashioned train ride. Travel, as it was during the early 20th century, restful and unhurried. Sit back and watch our countryside roll by your window, as the whistle is sounded for each crossing. Our first generation diesel locomotive pulls three vintage coaches as you ride in either our Air Conditioned coach or two commuter cars. Investigate our rolling gift shop car enroute or have a light snack, with advance notice box lunches are available with a selection of sandwiches. The coaches were built in 1925 and 1927.

All departures board the train at the Jefferson Depot platform, which is the start, and finish point of your ride. Travel begins northward to our Carson Yard interchange with Norfolk Southern. At times NS freight trains can be seen rumbling by on nearby trackage which runs between Ashtabula and Youngstown. The AC&J operates year round freight line as well as passenger operations.
