AT OUR TICKET BOOTH. A POST CARD IS SENT,
TIME PERMITTING (2 WEEKS OR MORE TO EVENT).

Children of all ages will enjoy an hour train ride with Santa on board on our *Carson Express*.

You will board at historic Jefferson Depot; ride in one of our vintage coaches for a winter exploration along our tracks. Look onto the snow-scaped fields and woods, crossing over two bridges as you ride to meet Santa and Mrs. Claus at our North Pole at Carson Yard.

Upon arrival Santa and Mrs. Claus will wave to all as the train passes their North Pole village. Then board the train to visit with all the boys and girls on the return trip to Jefferson. Santa will have some of his helpers assist in distributing gifts.



Santa and Mrs. Claus have scheduled a short time for pictures after arriving at Jefferson before returning to their North Pole workshop.

About our train and the Santa ride, round trip will last approximately 1 hour and covers twelve miles of Ashtabula County back farm country.

Our locomotive is a first generation Diesel pulling our full sized vintage railroad coaches from 1925 & 1927. Full sized cars are enclosed, heated and are decorated for the season. There is a lavatory on board available after leaving the station.

The AC&J is not handicap accessible.

How To Find Us:

From Warren/Youngstown

Take Route 11 North to Route 307 West, turn right on 46 (307 also goes to the right). At the 2nd traffic light, by the courthouse, turn right onto East Jefferson Street, travel two blocks, cross our tracks and turn left into Western Reserve Lumber, street address 161 E Jefferson.

From Cleveland/Lake County

Use I90 eastbound, you can follow the Erie PA signs. Upon reaching Ashtabula/Warren exit route 45, at Austinburg, go south towards Warren. One-mile south, at the 3rd traffic light, you will reach route 307, turn left onto 307 east. At the north end of Jefferson there is a traffic light. Turn right onto route 46, at the 3rd traffic light, by the courthouse, turn left onto East Jefferson Street. We are 2 long blocks, cross our tracks and turn left into Western Reserve Lumber, street address 161 E Jefferson.



NOTICE: Our Neighbor, the adjacent Jefferson Depot Village, if open, is independently operated and is **NOT** included with your train ticket.
