Visit free a saloon full of gamblers (Sarsaparilla to be served only), blacksmith and shop at period merchants or our General Store. Witness a street shoot-out and bank robbery and more.

Round trip will last approximately an hour and a quarter and will cover twelve miles through Ashtabula County back farm country.

Our locomotive is a first generation Diesel pulling three full sized vintage coaches dating from 1925 & 1927. There is one lavatory available after leaving the station.

NOTE: Schedules are adhered to as closely as possible, but the railroad reserves the right to alter schedules, change fares, substitute coaches and/or motive power as operating conditions demand. The railroad is not responsible for a lack of sufficient capacity. Only certified guide/service dogs accompanying passengers with disabilities are permitted on train. The AC&J is not handicap accessible.

Directions, how to find us
From Youngstown/Warren/Pittsburgh

Take Ohio route 11 north to route 307 west, turn right on route 46 (307 also goes to the right). At the 2nd traffic light, by the courthouse, turn right onto East Jefferson Street. We are 2 long blocks, cross our tracks and turn left into Western Reserve Lumber, street address 161 E Jefferson.

From Cleveland/Lake County

Use I90 eastbound, you can follow the Erie PA signs. Upon reaching Ashtabula/Warren exit at Austinburg go south on 45 towards Warren. One-mile south you will reach 307 east, turn left. At the north end of Jefferson there is a traffic light. Turn right onto route 46, at the 3rd traffic light, by the courthouse turn left onto East Jefferson Street. We are 2 long blocks, cross our tracks and turn left into Western Reserve Lumber, street address 161 E Jefferson.

NOTE: The adjacent Jefferson Depot Village is independently operated and NOT included with your train ticket.
